ERNEST PARKER, former UKA member, is playing both sides in this political race and is donating money to both campaigns.

A few days ago PHILIP BUIE, a Negro male who resides on Canal Street, Natchez, Mississippi, and who is employed as a butcher at the Shady Side Grocery owned by ARISTO GANBERRY, advised as follows:

BUIE said that JOE HARDY had caught GANBERRY and HARDY's wife together in the store room of GANBERRY's store in a compromising position. HARDY's wife has been employed at this store for some time. The Negro employees of the store overheard talk of this incident and HARDY allegedly beat his wife over this incident. HARDY also allegedly put pressure on GANBERRY concerning this incident and as a result GANBERRY is paying HARDY's wife an extra \$20 per week which is not shown on the payroll books to keep the incident quiet. GANBERRY is very concerned that his wife may find out about this incident.

BUIE also stated that the Negroes in the Natchez area suspect a white man who resides on Morgantown Road near Natchez, as having been responsible for the bombing of WHARLEST JACKSON. This man allegedly has knowledge of explosives but was not identified by BUIE. BUIE stated that Negroes in the area were fearful to reveal this information because there are a number of known Klansmen who live in the area of Morgantown Road.

Source stated that when Negroes started integrating the Riveroaks Apartments, police came to this location, which is out of the city. ROUSE allegedly met the police with a shotgun and told them to leave, that it was out of the city and that "We'll take care of it."

On March 16, 1967, [FOIA(b)(7) - (D)] advised SA's BENJAMIN F. GRAVES and THOMPSON BERRY WEBB that JOE HARDY had come to klavern meetings with a .38 pistol.

On March 23, 1967, [FOIA(b)(7) - (D)] advised SA THOMPSON BERRY WEBB that a couple of months ago NETTLES, CARTER and JERRY MOON, and several others, were talking at CARTER's place. Source heard NETTLES offer MOON \$100 if he would take NETTLES' Dodge Charger and totally wreck it. MOON was heard to say that he couldn't, sure as he did he would be killed over it. NETTLES has been in bad financial shape according to his close friend, JOE LEE HARDY. In fact, at a klavern meeting in the past when purchase of robes was being discussed, HARDY requested that they let Mrs. PERCY NETTLES make them as they were hardup. This was immediately squelched as it was pointed out that NETTLES was not a member. Allegedly, there were two cars stolen from around Armstrong the night after the JACKSON bombing. The first was recovered badly wrecked. The second was PERCY NETTLES' Dodge Charger. The source strongly suspects that JOE HARDY, as he was not working at the International Paper Company, was furnished a key to NETTLES' Charger and subsequently put the Charger in the river.

On March 9, 1967, JOE SILAS BUNCH, JR. advised SA's JAMES R. MC GEE and THOMAS J. CONNOLLY that JOE HARDY was unknown to him.
